

## Biosketch of Allan Flyvbjerg



Allan Flyvbjerg is 60 years old and graduated from Aarhus University, Denmark in 1986, defended his thesis (DMSc) in 1993, became specialist in Endocrinology and Internal Medicine in 1999, Chief Physician in 2001, Professor in Experimental Medical Research in 2005, Chair in Endocrinology in 2009 and Dean of the Faculty of Health, Aarhus University in 2011.

In 2016 he was appointed CEO of Steno Diabetes Center Copenhagen and Professor in Clinical Endocrinology at the University of Copenhagen, Denmark.

His research embraces pre-clinical and clinical research focused on the pathogenesis leading to - and the treatment of - diabetic angiopathy. He is author of >600 scientific publications and well-cited. He has contributed as editor and author to numerous Textbooks within Diabetes. He was member of the editorial board of the Journal of the American Society of Nephrology from 2001–2004, and Associate Editor of Diabetologia from 2007–2013. Finally, he has received numerous national and international awards for his scientific contribution.

Allan Flyvbjerg was President of the Danish Diabetes Association from 2000–2011 and is member of several national and international boards and councils. In the period 2016-2017 he was member of the 'Growth team for life-science' established by the Danish Government. Since 2018 he has been Chairman of Board of Directors in the Danish Diabetes Academy, a talent development program for future researcher and clinicians within diabetes. In 2019 he became honorary member of the Danish Diabetes Association. Finally, in 2019 he graduated from the Copenhagen Business School (CBS) with the CBS Executive Board of Director Education.
